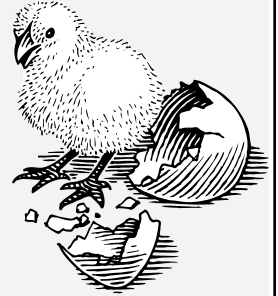
This is the only time of the year that the public is invited inside to tour our facility.

such as paintings, sculptures, toys, lamps, furniture, jewelry, even a small cannon!

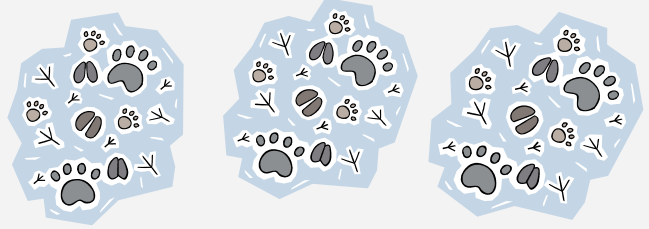

Cash for Critters is an opportunity to earn prizes and provide much needed money to care for the baby animals.

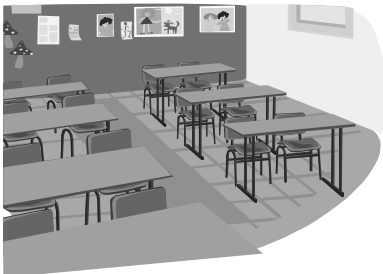
