Run For The Wild 2012 April 7, 2012



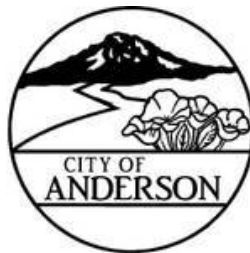
Shasta Wildlife's annual Run For The Wild promises to be an exciting event again this year. The fun-run will offer 5-mile, 2-mile and 1/4-mile run/walks and fun for all ages.

The day before the race (Friday, April 6, 2012), runners will be able to pick up their registration packets. And this year we are able to offer three locations for pick up: Fleet Feet in Redding from 10:00am to 4:00pm, and two Mary's Pizza Shack locations in either Redding or Anderson from 11:00am to 7:00pm. We hope this will make pick ups easier for all runners. So that we can have your packet at the best location for you, it is imperative that your choice is indicated on the registration form (see page 3).

Wherever you decide to pick up your packet, be sure to eat at Mary's Pizza Shacks (either location) on Friday and bring the whole family (neighbors too) and Mary's will donate 25% of your total ticket to Shasta Wildlife. 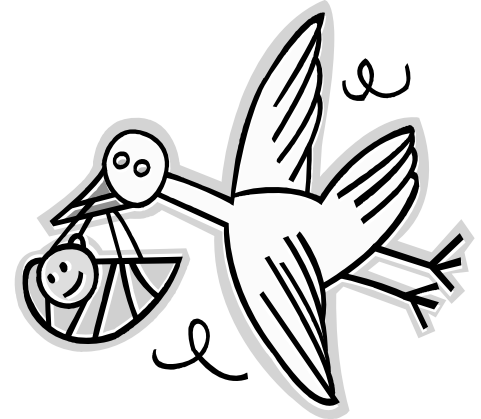

most recent work is "The Unstoppable Eagles", released on February 10, 2012. Terri has wonderful stories to read and share with the whole family.

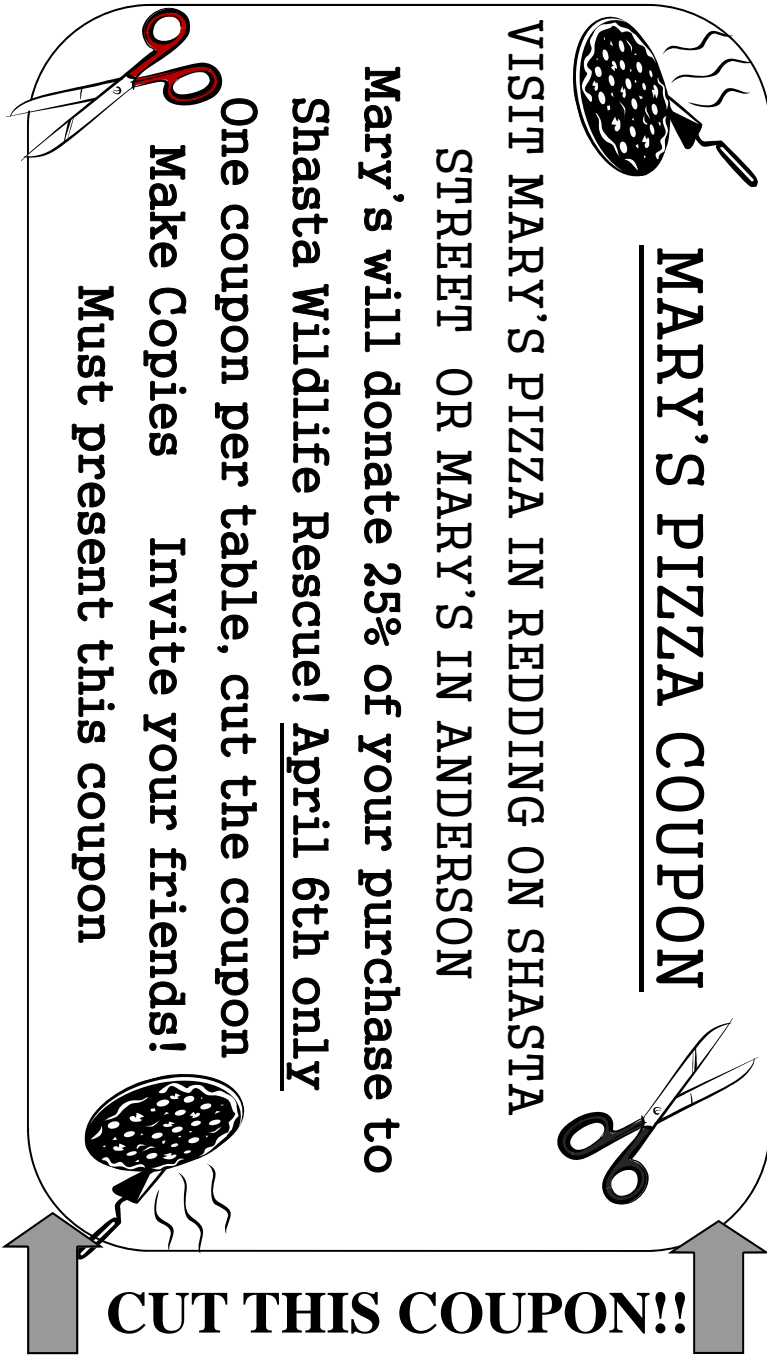
